

72031 Operator controls of external power supply (230 V / 24V) manual forward / reverse



- 1 Main switch
- 2 Power indicator ROTAQLEEN
- 3 Selector switch manual/radio
- 4 Connection socket ROTAQLEEN
- 5 Current indicator
- 6 Power plug for electrical connection 230V
- 7 Remote control

Connection and construction

Connect the power plug (6) with a socket. The current indicator (5) lights up white.

Connection of the ROTAQLEEN

Unroll the cable drum to the required length and connect the cable connection from the inside of the cable drum to the connection socket ROTAQLEEN (4) on the external power supply unit. Connect the end of the unrolled cable with the ROTAQLEEN brush.

Commissioning and operating

Manual operation

Set the selector switch manual / radio (3) to manual mode. Choose the running direction of the ROTAQLEEN with the main switch (1).

Caution! The ROTAQLEEN starts immediately when selecting the running direction.

Radio operation

Set the selector-switch manual / radio (3) to radio operation mode. Choose the running direction of the ROTAQLEEN with the main switch (1). Choose the „I“ on the remote control (7) to turn on the ROTAQLEEN and „0“ to turn off.
